**Required Qualifications**

**Qualifications** To be eligible for core privileges in the Department of Surgery - Orthopedics, the applicant must be a member of the medical staff and satisfy the following requirements or equivalents thereof as determined by the Department Chair and/or designee:

- Possess a current, unlimited license to practice in New York State
- Provide proof of appropriate and current malpractice coverage
- Successfully completed an ACGME or AOA accredited residency program in Orthopedics
- Possess current board certification or be considered board eligible in Orthopedic Surgery by the American Board of Orthopedic Surgery (ABOS) or American Osteopathic Board of Orthopedic Surgery (AOBOS).
- Non-ACGME fellowships, international programs or other types of training will be assessed on a case by basis, and left to the discretion of the Department Chair.
- All new surgeons will be on provisional status for a period of time until considered appropriate to be considered full active status, this is left to the discretion of the Department Chair.
- On-Call Privileges for Orthopedic Trauma, Spine, and Hand (if applicable) is at the sole and complete discretion of the Department Chair and Division Chief.

**Initial Appointment** Applicants for initial appointment may be requested to provide documentation of the number and types of hospital cases performed during the past 24 months. Applicants have the burden of producing information deemed adequate by the hospital for a proper evaluation of current competence and other qualifications and for resolving any doubts.

**Renewal of Privileges** To be eligible to renew core privileges in Orthopedic Surgery, the applicant must meet the following Maintenance of Privileges criteria:

- Current demonstrated competence and an adequate volume of experience with acceptable results in the privileges requested for the past 24 months based on results of quality assessment/improvement activities and outcomes. Evidence of current ability to perform privileges requested is required of all applicants for renewal of privileges.
